The undersigned hereby applies for a SPECIAL TRANSPORT PERMIT to transport vehicles and/or loads exceeding limits fixed by statute, as follows:

A. IF REQUESTED PERMIT IS GRANTED, THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES:

1. To inspect the route to make sure that it is in good traveling condition.
2. To observe all safety regulations required by the State of Colorado when moving on Teller County roads.
3. To take every precaution to protect the highways and the traffic from damage or injury, using pilot cars or flagmen to warn the traveling public on all blind curves, both vertical and horizontal.
4. In case of over width of load, the same is to be placed on the vehicle with the overhangs as far to the right as possible, and in any event the material shall be loaded as to present the minimum hazard to traffic.
5. To make this traffic movement only between DAYLIGHT and DARK, and to remove the traffic load from the highway except between those hours.
6. To be financially responsible and to make prompt payment for any damage caused or to highway or bridges by the transportation of this load in excess of limitation prescribed by state statute.
7. That the operator(s) of the vehicles(s) are duly licensed according to statute.
8. To operate the vehicle(s) at all times in accordance with any and all provisions of law, except as exempted herein with regard to motor vehicles and the operation thereof.
9. Except when a permit is requested and granted for over-weight, the undersigned applicant specifically states that his load is legal weight and the same cannot be loaded to conform with the statute.
10. A bond shall be posted with Teller County, if required, to cover the cost of damage to bridges and road.

It is understood by the applicant that this permit when issued is valid only on those roads and highways under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners of Teller County, Colorado.

This application when signed by the Teller County Administrator or his authorized agent, shall be an approved permit subject to the understanding that no liability is assumed by the County of Teller by reason of its issuance, in regard to conditions or roads or capacity of culverts and bridges and the applicant is charged to make necessary examination and inspection as to the adequacy of roads and bridges to care for the traffic movement. In case of an emergency, the Teller County Administrator or his authorized agent have authority to suspend this permit until utility emergency conditions have passed.
