## Requirements:

### -Tuition Cost: \$1,500

- Must be 21 years or older
- Must be free of any felony convictions and certain misdemeanors.
- Must be hired by Teller County Sheriff's Office or any other law enforcement agency.
- Must possess a valid High School Diploma/GED.
- Must possess a valid Colorado License.
- Must be able to meet attendance requirements.
- Must undergo both a physical and a psychological evaluation.

## FAQs

Q: How many total hours is the Reserve Academy?

A: Colorado P.O.S.T. requires 200 hours for a Reserve Academy.

Q: What are students required to provide and bring to class each day?

A: Students are required to purchase duty belt & hand-cuffs with case. Uniforms and Weapons will be provided

Q: Is there a commitment to TCSO after I have completed and graduated from the Academy?

A: There is a monthly 16 hour minimum requirement to maintain your POST reserve certification.

Q: What is the application process for the Academy?

A: In order to be considered for the Academy you will undergo interviews, background investigation, and Medical & Psychological evaluation.

Q: What are the physical fitness requirements for attending the Academy?

A: Students must be able to pass the Arrest Control Training
