4:57PM The Board of County Commissioners of Teller County convened in emergency session in the Teller County Centennial Building in Cripple Creek with Chairman Bergeman presiding.

At the request of Sheriff Kevin Dougherty, Fire Marshall of Teller County the Board of County Commissioners of Teller County were requested to adopted a resolution concerning the implementation of the level 3 fire ban for the following reasons; 1)due to the “red flag” weather conditions; 2) the dry conditions throughout the County; 3) and the wildfires currently burning in Boulder and Douglas, Counties.

Mr. Winkler was requested to read Resolution 10-29-03 (53) implementing a level 3 fire ban in unincorporated Teller County.

Mr. Bergeman asked if there was any public comment regarding the resolution and it’s contents and after hearing no public comment, Mr. Ignatius moved to adopt Resolution 10-29-03 (53) and Mr. Campbell seconded the motion.

All Commissioners voted yes.

There being no other business to come before the Board the meeting was adjourned at 5:05pm.
