Job Title: Transportation Maintenance Worker I Classification: Non-Exempt

SUMMARY OF JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

A Transportation Maintenance Worker I in the Transportation Division performs semi-skilled work in the operation of heavy and light equipment for constructing, maintaining, repairing and improving County roads; some physical labor may also be required.

<u>FUNCTIONS/TASKS:</u> (All persons, with or without reasonable accommodation, who can perform the essential functions/tasks required of this job or position will receive full consideration toward it.)

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- (1) Perform semi-skilled and technical procedures in road and bridge maintenance and construction including tunnels and right-of-way easements; operate heavy and light equipment and trucks in all phases of road and bridge construction, maintenance and improvement, as well as during emergency situations.
- (2). Operate a variety of heavy and light equipment in emergency situations including snow removal and other weather or disaster related incidents.
- (3) Responsible for proper care of assigned equipment.
- (4) Responsible for keeping service center, building and grounds in a clean and orderly condition.
- (5) Attend safety and job training classes.

OTHER FUNCTIONS/TASKS:

(6) Perform all other duties as assigned

<u>MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:</u> (The following requirements are necessary to reasonably ensure the County that the individual selected for this position will be able to perform the essential functions, tasks of the position.)

(1) Skills/Knowledge:

Working knowledge and ability to operate basic heavy equipment and assorted light equipment and trucks. Ability to provide day-to-day maintenance of equipment.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees and the public.

- (2) <u>Experience/Education:</u> High school diploma or GED plus proven work experience as a heavy equipment operator and/or truck driver or any equivalent combination of training and experience.
- (3) <u>Visual Acuity/Hearing/Speaking:</u> Effective verbal communication skills.
- (4) <u>Physical Effort/Dexterity:</u> Must be in good physical condition with the ability to lift and carry 80 pounds. Must be able to use a variety of hand tools.

- (5) <u>Environmental Factors:</u> Must be able to work under adverse conditions for extended periods of time. Such conditions will include dirt, noise, rain, snow and extremes of temperatures.
- (6) <u>Work Schedule/Characteristics:</u> 40 hours per week. Varied work schedules are required during certain weather conditions.
- (7) <u>Special Requirements:</u> Possession of a valid Colorado Commercial Driver's License with the ability to obtain a Class A Commercial Driver's License within 90 days from date of hire. Must be willing to obtain special license endorsements as required.
