**Teller County Prevails on Preliminary Injunction –
Court Orders Andrew Wommack Ministries Inc. to Comply with Public Health Orders**

Tuesday afternoon Judge David S. Prince of the 4th Judicial District issued an order granting Teller County and the State of Colorado’s request for a preliminary injunction requiring Andrew Wommack Ministries Inc (AWMInc) to comply with the State’s COVID-19 Public Health Orders.

The Order enjoins AWMInc from holding or hosting a conference or other event that does not comply with the Public Health Orders, including the social distancing and masking requirements and the attendance caps (currently 175 plus staff for indoor events). The order further enjoins AWMInc from barring or limiting access to public health officials to determine compliance with the Public Health Orders.

Teller County Administrator stated “Teller County is pleased that the court issued a thorough and well-reasoned opinion that upholds the State’s reasonable, non-discriminatory public health orders to help protect our community from the spread of COVID-19. We expect that AWMInc will comply with the court order, adhere to the attendance limits, wear masks and practice social distancing at its conferences and events.”
