HOW CAN MONOCLONAL ANTIBODY COVID-19 TREATMENT HELP YOU?

- Monoclonal antibody (mAb) treatment
 - How does it work?
 - mAb works like your own immune system and will help your immune system to destroy the COVID-19 virus.
 - In clinical trials mAb showed that those who tested positive for COVID-19 and received mAb treatment within 10 days of symptom onset experienced fewer symptoms and hospitalizations.
 - Minimal side effects; anaphylaxis is rare.
 - REGEN-COV showed a 70% decrease in COVID-19 related hospitalizations and death compared to placebo.
 - mAb have also been shown to reduce the risk of infection if given prophylactically for post-exposure.
 - Benefits of mAb
 - Reduce severity of COVID-19 symptoms and progression of the illness
